Hexaware is headquartered in Mumbai, India and operates in 19 countries. It has more than 28,500 employees across 54 global offices. In FY22 the company generated \$1.2 billion in revenue, with Financial Services as its largest segment. In the U.S., it is focusing on delivering effective cloud managed services with its industry-specific solution for midmarket clients. Hexaware primarily focuses on serving sectors such as financial services, healthcare and pharmaceuticals, travel and transportation, retail and business services.

**Strong IaC practice:** Hexaware uses IaC in all transformations through DevOps engagements to assist clients in developing, deploying and scaling cloud applications more quickly, safely and at a reduced cost.
