## Overview

Hexaware is headquartered in Mumbai, India. It has more than 28,500 employees across 54 offices in 19 countries. In FY22, the company generated \$1.2 billion in revenue, with Financial Services as its largest segment. Hexaware has approximately 4,500 employees in the Americas, distributed among 11 delivery centers and one central office. The region accounts for approximately 72 percent of the company's revenue.

Hexaware's automation-driven proprietary tool, Amaze® for Modernization, accelerates maturity assessment and empowers the successful execution of legacy modernization engagements. The company also has a modern delivery framework and proprietary tools such as RapidX<sup>™</sup> and Tensai®.

The company proposes five-year deals to convert and migrate applications within three years, with a focus on optimizing operations within five years. Its robust project management methodology leverages a project dashboard to control each step of the modernization process.

Hexaware runs pre-assessments with Amaze® for Assessment, providing an upfront understanding of the cost, risk, and business value. It focuses on a client's business challenge to seize the opportunity and optimize applications toward a clear business goal. Subsequently, it introduces short optimization cycles to meet the established goals, leveraging an agile approach to modernize the client's business. It also uses automation to minimize manual efforts.
