# Hexaware

## Overview

Hexaware is headquartered in Mumbai, India, and operates in 30 countries. It has more than 28,000 employees across 37 global offices. In FY21, the company generated \$971 million in revenue, of which 70 percent was contributed by the Americas. It delivers mainframe modernizations with Amaze® for Legacy, an automation-driven proprietary solution based on best practices that comprise granular discovery, functional domain decoupling and accelerated migration.

## Strengths

**Precise execution control:** Hexaware delivers consistent project planning and execution, assuring clients with transparency and risk control. It runs a granular discovery and functional domain decoupling assessment to plan new releases every three weeks and milestones every four weeks, enabling it to identify problems and apply corrections immediately.

**Data-centric documentation:** Hexaware creates a catalog of data services, where it decouples monolithic applications, enabling partial portfolio conversions. It uses Amaze and partner tools from Cast Software and Updraft to assess and discover technical components. Amaze produces rich documentation for legacy applications and explains the logic and functions.

**Top tooling for conversion:** The company selects the best modernization tools from 13 partners, including TmaxSoft, Micro Focus, LzLabs, Updraft, AWS/BluAge, Mobilize.Net, CloufFrame and Heirloom. Hexaware claims that Amaze can reduce the time required to convert six million lines of code by half.

## Caution

Hexaware partners with hyperscalers but is not yet listed among their certified partners for mainframe migrations. The company should consider investing in more cloud certifications.
